Even though the computers are donated, ArtsTech has a cost to refurbish the PCs and make certain the PC is functioning at its maximum capacity.

ArtsTech works diligently to keep the cost down. The PCs may be picked up at our Kansas City location or they can be shipped anywhere in Missouri and Kansas.

Computer Redistribution Program

CRP is a collaborative venture between the National Cristina Foundation and ArtsTech to provide persons with disabilities and other needy individuals, schools, and non-profit agencies with refurbished computer equipment.

ArtsTech distributes 500+ computers each year to people with disabilities, at-risk individuals, and organizations that serve these special populations. ArtsTech is grateful to the businesses, schools, and individuals that donate used computers for refurbishing.

Computer Sales

ArtsTech offers quality refurbished Pentium III computer systems at cost. Most units include a CD-ROM, 56K modem or network card, and 2000 operating system. Other accessories/peripherals are available at a very reasonable cost. Refurbished computers come with a 6-month warranty.

New computers can also be built to meet your specific requirements. These units will have typical manufacturer warranties.

Networking Services

ArtsTech can build network computer labs with your current equipment or with refurbished computers. Maintenance agreement and technology plan development for organizations or schools are also offered.

Computer Repair Training

The troubleshooting class that provides a hands-on opportunity for youth and adult learners to master basic techniques and skills for diagnosing, repairing, and upgrading computers. Upon successful completion of the 20-hour course, learners will be given the computer they refurbished, along with the toolkit used in class. These repair and diagnostic skills can save hundreds of dollars in costly repairs and down time.

Experienced, professional instructors conduct each program. On-site programs can be tailored to meet the specific needs and requirements of your school or organization.
